

1.1 Senator ..... moves to amend S.F. No. 3045, in conference committee, as follows:

1.2 On R55-A9, House language, (UES3045-2)

1.3 Page 80, delete section 38 and insert:

1.4 "Sec. 38. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 204D.19, subdivision 2, is amended to read:

1.5 Subd. 2. **Special election when legislature will be in session.** Except for vacancies in  
 1.6 the legislature which occur at any time between the last day of session in an odd-numbered  
 1.7 year and the 40th day prior to the opening day of session in the succeeding even-numbered  
 1.8 year, when a vacancy occurs and the legislature will be in session so that the individual  
 1.9 elected as provided by this section could take office and exercise the duties of the office  
 1.10 immediately upon election, the governor shall issue within five days after the vacancy occurs  
 1.11 a writ calling for a special election. The filing period for the vacancy must be a minimum  
 1.12 of three days, excluding holidays. The special election shall be held as soon as possible,  
 1.13 consistent with the notice requirements of section 204D.22, subdivision 3, but in no event  
 1.14 more than 35 days after the issuance of the writ. A special election must not be held during  
 1.15 the ~~four~~ two days before or the ~~four~~ two days after a holiday as defined in section 645.44,  
 1.16 subdivision 5.

1.17 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment and  
 1.18 applies to vacancies in legislative offices that occur on or after that date."

1.19 On R56-A9, House language, (UES3045-2)

1.20 Page 81, after line 15, insert:

1.21 "Sec. 40. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 204D.195, is amended to read:

1.22 **204D.195 DATE OF SPECIAL ELECTION; CERTAIN TIMES PROHIBITED.**

1.23 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a special primary and special general election  
 1.24 may not be held:

1.25 (1) for a period beginning the day following the date of the state primary election and  
 1.26 ending the day prior to the date of the state general election; or

1.27 (2) on a holiday, or during the ~~four~~ two days before or after a holiday, as defined in  
 1.28 section 645.44, subdivision 5."

1.29 Renumber the sections in sequence and correct the internal references

1.30 Amend the title accordingly
