Dear Chair Wiklund and Members of the Committee:

Minnesota's Prenatal to Three Coalition (PN-3) is excited to support HF 2900, the Governor's proposed investments in the Department of Human Services, as an investment in children and families. Families are struggling to meet daily expenses and challenges, and many of the investments in HF 2900 will help families with young children get a strong, stable start. The PN-3 Coalition would like to highlight key provisions that are necessary to improve the health and wellbeing of young children, birthing people, and families.

Child Care Article 1. Beginning on Line 2.22

The staffing, funding, and capacity issues in the early childhood field has negatively impacted the industry most families rely on for their children's early care and education. This investment in the early childhood workforce will help stabilize the field by improving recruitment, education and retention strategies to equitably support those providing critical care and education to Minnesota's youngest learners.

Direct Reimbursement for Doula Services [148.995] Article 8. Sec. 13. Line 150.14

As advocates and birthing educators, doulas should have the ability to bill directly for their services. By allowing doulas to be directly reimbursed for their services, they will be able to overcome the many barriers that come with the supervisor requirement.

The PN-3 Coalition believes all young children and families in Minnesota should have a Great Start in life, regardless of income level. Please support HF 2900 to ensure more children have access to the care and learning programs they need to be successful in school and in life. Increasing funding to high quality maternal and child health programs will increase access for more children and their families to be positively positioned for lifetime of success.
