CARTS TO CAREERS PROGRAM CRITERIA



What is the MGA Carts to Careers Program?

The Minnesota Grocers Association Foundation's Carts to Careers program receives ongoing funding through a State of Minnesota appropriation/grant that provides us—and you—the opportunity to provide tuition support to your employees seeking education and training in the food industry.

What Type of Education/Training is Supported?

The following are required for any education/training to be eligible for this grant:

- Must be education/training in the Minnesota food industry
- Must be an outsourced training program (cannot be in-house) and replicable outside of your organization
- Must be for employees' career advancement in industry
- Must be able to provide proof of completion (e.g., certificate of completion, plaque)
- Examples of actual education/training programs include:
 - Retail Management Certificate through Alexandria Technical & Community College (2-year college credit online program)
 - CDL licensing training
 - Leadership training for career advancement in industry
 - Meat cutting training
 - Accounting certification courses

Who is Eligible?

Eligible applicants:

- Must be a current full or part-time employee of a Minnesota Grocers Association member company
- Must be employed as of the application date and throughout program
- Must be committed to expanding their career within the Minnesota food industry
- Must have Supervisor/Manager support (letter of recommendation and company commitment of 50% of tuition)





Tuition support is made available through a State of Minnesota grant and MGA Foundation funding.



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
