

## INCOME AND RACE/ETHNICITY

### St. David's Center Early Intervention Services

- ▶ **67%** of families are low-income
- ▶ **47%** are BIPOC\* families

### The Harman Center (Minneapolis Clinic)

- ▶ **90%** of families are low-income
- ▶ **67%** are BIPOC\* families

*\*Families are not required to self-report this information to access services.  
 "Low Income" is based on the proxy measure of families accessing Medicaid to cover the cost of services.  
 "BIPOC" reflects the percent of families who completed demographic information and self-reported identifying as Black, Indigenous, African, Hispanic, Hmong, or Multiracial.*
