Overview

This bill contains a variety of policy proposals related to secure facilities and the discharge of jail inmates.

Summary

Section	Description
1	Public notice of restriction, revocation, or suspension. Clarifies that the commissioner of corrections is required to provide public notice when a correctional facility's license is restricted by the commissioner due to a correction order.
2	Medical aid. Prohibits counties from charging jail inmates for external phone calls made by inmates to mental health care providers.
3	Discharge. Modifies the commissioner of corrections' obligation to develop and distribute a model discharge planning process for jails. Establishes a timeline for development of a discharge plan for mentally ill jail inmates. Authorizes counties to establish reentry coordination programs.
4	Appropriation. Proposes a blank appropriation to fund county reentry coordination programs under section 3.
