1.2 Page 1, line 20, after "made" insert "for purposes of civil immigration enforcement"

1.3 Page 5, delete subdivision 2 and insert:

1.4 "Subd. 2. **Definitions.** For purposes of this section, the following terms have the meanings  
1.5 given:

1.6 (1) "campus" means:

1.7 (i) any building or property owned or controlled by a postsecondary institution within  
1.8 the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the institution and used by the institution  
1.9 in direct support of, or in a manner related to, the institution's educational purposes, including  
1.10 but not limited to residence halls; and

1.11 (ii) property within the same reasonably contiguous geographic area of the institution  
1.12 that is owned by the institution but controlled by another person, is used by students, and  
1.13 supports institutional purposes, including but not limited to a food or other retail vendor;  
1.14 and

1.15 (2) "federal immigration officer" means a person acting in their official capacity as an  
1.16 officer or employee of a United States agency that enforces civil immigration law, including  
1.17 but not limited to United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement and United States  
1.18 Customs and Border Protection."

1.19 Page 5, line 19, delete "required by state or federal law or as required" and insert  
1.20 "provided in paragraph (d)"

1.21 Page 5, line 20, delete "to administer a state or federally supported educational program"

1.22 Page 6, after line 3, insert:

2.1 "(d) Paragraph (a) does not restrict campus access by a federal immigration officer that  
2.2 is:

2.3 (1) required by state or federal law;

2.4 (2) required to administer a state or federally supported education program; or

2.5 (3) for purposes of voluntary training, outreach, and support provided through the federal  
2.6 student exchange and visitor program."

2.7 Page 6, before line 4, insert:

2.8 "Subd. 4. **Information to students.** (a) During student registration, a postsecondary  
2.9 institution must provide each student with information regarding:

2.10 (1) a student's constitutional rights with regard to civil immigration enforcement;

2.11 (2) recommended best practices for student safety when interacting with a federal  
2.12 immigration officer; and

2.13 (3) the requirements imposed on the postsecondary institution by this section.

2.14 A copy of this information also shall be posted at appropriate locations on campus at all  
2.15 times.

2.16 (b) The commissioner of the Office of Higher Education, in consultation with the attorney  
2.17 general, must develop standardized language that a postsecondary institution may use to  
2.18 meet the requirements of paragraph (a).

2.19 Subd. 5. **Liability limited.** Nothing in this section shall be construed to create any  
2.20 personal liability for an official, staff member, or other employee of a postsecondary  
2.21 institution acting in good faith."
