Overview

State laws on firearms explicitly prevent local governments from passing firearm regulations.

This bill repeals five sections of law that establish state preemption on this topic.

Summary

Section	Description
1	Zoning ordinances. Makes conforming changes related to sections of law that are being repealed.
2	Repealer. Repeals sections 471.663 (firearms); 417.634 (definition); 624.714, subdivision 23 (exclusivity); 624.717 (local regulation); and 624.7191, subdivision 4 (metal-penetrating bullets). Those sections of law establish that state law on the regulation of firearms preempts local action on that topic.
