Thank you for hearing <u>HF 1851</u> and to Representative Hicks for authoring the bill. Olmsted County urges your support for this legislation to establish "*Live Well at Home*" grants.

The *Live Well at Home* grants will lead to new and expanded programs as well as providing ongoing funding for programs and services with a proven track record of positive outcomes for older adults and people with dementia. This grant funding will offer community providers added stability as they provide home and community-based services and family caregiver support for seniors not eligible for medical assistance. Our community providers are a critical component in creating an age friendly environment in our community and this bill would provide these community partners important funding to continue that mission.
