## **University of Minnesota Promise Scholarship Programs (2022)**

One of our major scholarship programs is the University of Minnesota Promise Program, which supports approximately 13,000-14,000 Minnesota families on an annual basis. The Promise Program provides eligible Minnesota undergraduate students funds to support their collegiate aspirations.

There are currently three programs under the Promise Program umbrella:

**U Promise Scholarship Program** - Provides eligible Minnesota students need-based scholarships based on family household income.

• For example, a freshman with a family household income of \$120,000 or lower would receive between \$300 to \$4,000 each year for four years depending on income.

**Promise Plus** - Provides **free** tuition based on household income.

• Example: a Freshman with a family household income of \$50,000 or lower would have the full cost of tuition covered.

**Native American Promise Tuition Program** - Provides substantial financial support, in many cases free tuition, to first-year undergraduate students and transfer students from Tribal colleges who are enrolled citizens in one of Minnesota's 11 federally recognized Tribal Nations.

• Example: Freshman from a Tribal nation and a family household income of \$75,000 or lower would receive full tuition coverage.
