Overview

This bill modifies procedures, requirements, and civil actions related to obtaining the contents of a vehicle that has been towed to an impound lot.

Summary

Section Description

1 Retrieval of contents; right to reclaim.

Adds proof of identity to the documentation that must be presented when a vehicle owner seeks to retrieve contents from a towed vehicle. Provides for copying records.

2 Retrieval of contents; identification, medicine, and medical equipment.

Requires an impound lot operator to allow retrieval of specified contents from an impounded vehicle.

3 Retrieval of contents; notice of denial.

Requires private impound lot operators to give specific written reasons when denying a vehicle owner's request to retrieve the contents of a towed vehicle.

4 Retrieval of contents; public notice.

Requires private impound lot operators to post a notice regarding retrieval of impounded vehicle contents. Identifies the text of the notice.

5 Retrieval of contents; remedy.

Explicitly allows for a civil suit by the vehicle owner when a private impound lot operator violates requirements to release towed vehicle contents. Paragraph (c) provides for injunctive relief and attorney fees. Paragraph (d) provides for an additional liability of \$1,000 in damages, plus attorney fees, under a civil action that must be brought within one year of vehicle impoundment.
