Dedicated, Flexible, funding

- Olmsted County totals
 - 2023 \$698,982
 - 2024 \$886,828
 - 2025 \$842,426
 - 2026 \$676,526
- *Average funding \$776,191*
- Community Investments
 - Eviction Prevention
 - Wholistic Case Management
 - Emergency Response to Stable Housing
- *Investment amounts change based on local circumstances*



Eviction Prevention



- Partnership with (McKinney Vento liaisons)
 - School Staff match weekly evictions with addresses
 - Connect with impacted families
 - Local Homeless Prevention Aid funds the assistance
- 2025 Local Results
 - 94 evictions filed
 - 90 evictions prevented
 - **96% SUCCESS RATE**

Wholistic Case Management

- Connect families to community resources
- Three Social Workers Embedded within Schools
 - Connect directly with families
 - Provide Housing Case Management
- Employment Case Management
 - Assisted 61 individuals in finding employment in 2025



Emergency Response to Stable Housing

Hotel Stays

- 2025: 103 families assisted with hotel vouchers

Family Shelter

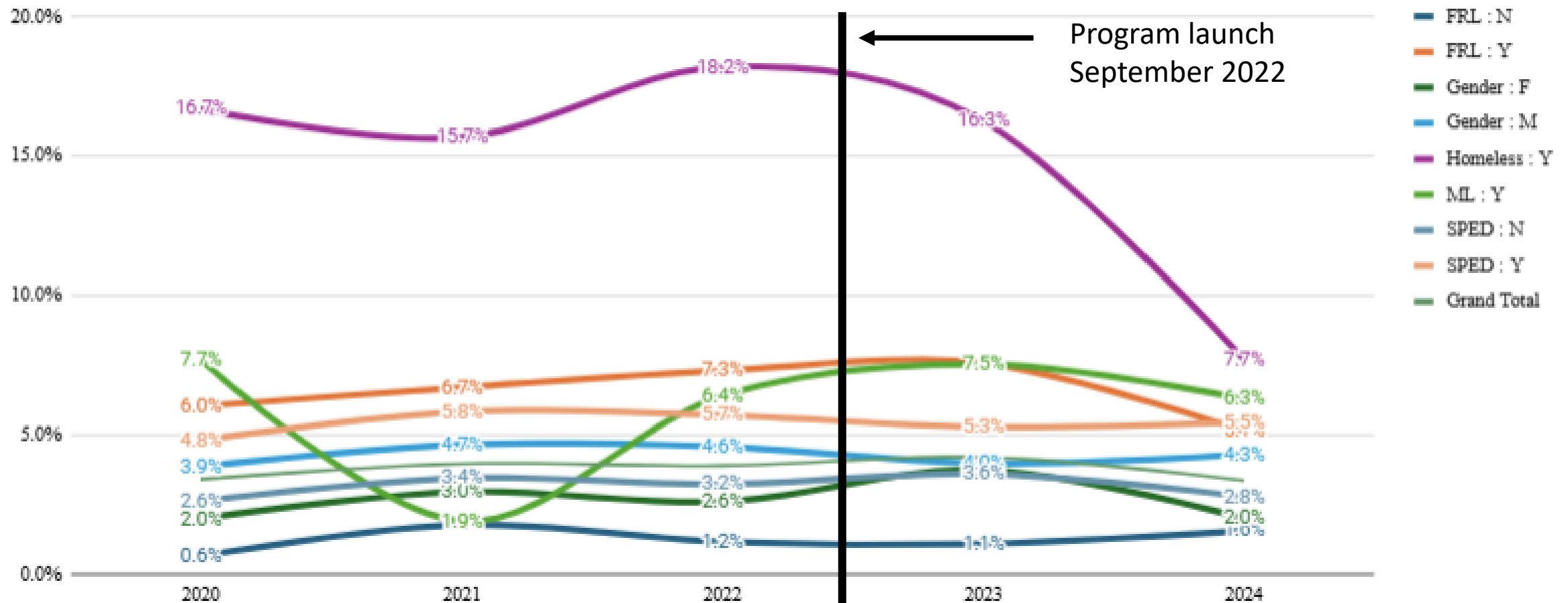
- Family Promise Rochester
- New family shelter opened in mid 2025
- Supported 63 individuals in 2025

Rental Assistance

- 52 families received rental assistance in 2025
