The class supports that were offered, made me feel like someone was doing the work for me. I did not feel like I was part of the class. I ended up dropping my classes. I need access to the classes I want to take. I need access to the support that helps me be successful. Inclusive Higher Education would eliminate the basic class requirements, and give me access to the classes I want to take and the support I need.

Today I have a part-time job as an Upstream Arts teaching artist. Artists that I work with have college degrees. For my performing arts career goals, I need a college education too.

I want to earn a college certificate in the performing arts. I need access to a college that is close to home, near public transportation, and affordable. I want a full-time career in the performing arts.
