1.4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
1.5	Section 1. [127A.853] PURPLE STAR SCHOOL DESIGNATION.
1.6	Subdivision 1. Definition. For purposes of this section, "military-connected student"
1.7	means a student who has an immediate family member, including a parent or sibling, who:
1.8	(1) is currently a member of the armed forces serving as either a reservist or on active duty
1.9	in the United States Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, or Coast Guard; (2) is currently
1.10	serving in the Minnesota National Guard; (3) has recently retired from the armed forces; or
1.11	(4) is the dependent of a member of the armed forces who was killed in the line of duty.
1.12	Subd. 2. Purple Star School. (a) The commissioner of education may designate a school
1.13	as a Purple Star School if the school:
1.14	(1) has a designated staff member serving as a military liaison whose duties include:
1.15	(i) identifying military-connected students enrolled at the school;
1.16	(ii) serving as the point of contact between the school and military-connected students
1.17	and families;
1.18	(iii) determining appropriate school services available to military-connected students;
1.19	and
1.20	(iv) assisting in coordinating school programs relevant to military-connected students;

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2.1	(2) maintains easily accessible information on the school website that includes resources
2.2	for military-connected students and families, including information regarding:
2.3	(i) student relocation, student enrollment, student registration, and transfer of school
2.4	records;
2.5	(ii) academic planning, course offerings, and advanced classes available at the school;
2.6	(iii) counseling and other support services available for military-connected students
2.7	enrolled at the school; and
2.8	(iv) the designated military liaison under clause (1);
2.9	(3) offers a transition program led by students, where appropriate, that assists
2.10	military-connected students in transitioning into the school;
2.11	(4) offers professional development opportunities for staff members on issues related
2.12	to military-connected students; and
2.13	(5) offers at least one of the following:
2.14	(i) a resolution showing support for military-connected students and families;
2.15	(ii) recognition of the Month of the Military Child or Military Family Month with relevant
2.16	events hosted by the school; or
2.17	(iii) a partnership with a local military installation that provides opportunities for active
2.18	duty military members to volunteer at the school, speak at an assembly, or host a field trip.
2.19	(b) The commissioner must establish a process for schools to seek Purple Star School
2.20	designation by July 1, 2026. The commissioner may award Purple Star School designations
2.21	starting in the 2026-2027 school year, and on an ongoing basis as schools meet qualifications
2.22	for the designation.
