Subject MA and MinnesotaCare Limits on Out-of-State Pharmacies

Overview

This bill limits the extent to which out-of-state pharmacies can provide pharmacy services to MA and MinnesotaCare enrollees.

Summary

Section Description

1 Eligible providers.

Amends § 256B.0625, by adding subd. 13k.

- (a) In order to dispense prescription drugs under MA, requires the dispensing provider to be a:
 - 1) pharmacy located within the state licensed by the Board of Pharmacy;
 - 2) physician located in a local trade area where there is no MA enrolled pharmacy; or
 - physician or advanced registered nurse practitioner employed by or under contract with a community health board for communicable disease control.
- (b) Allows a licensed out-of-state pharmacy to be enrolled as a dispensing provider if the pharmacy is:
 - 1) a retail pharmacy located within 50 miles of the Minnesota border that serves walk-in MA enrollees, and whose walk-in customers represent at least 75 percent of prescription volume;
 - 2) a retail pharmacy serving foster children who are enrolled in MA and live outside of Minnesota;
 - 3) serving enrollees receiving preapproved organ transplants who require medication during after-care while residing outside of Minnesota; or
 - 4) providing products with limited or exclusive distribution channels for which no potential dispensing provider is located within the state.

Section Description

Prescription drugs. 2

Amends § 256B.69, subd. 6d. Requires managed care and county-based purchasing plans, and any subcontractor including a pharmacy benefit manager, to comply with section 256B.0625, subdivision 13k, when contracting with dispensing providers to serve MA and MinnesotaCare enrollees.
