Bill Description

This bill establishes an exception to the moratorium on hospital construction or modification to allow Children’s Hospital in St. Paul to add 22 licensed beds to be used for pediatric inpatient behavioral health services. The bill permits the hospital to add licensed beds before completing a public interest review, provided the hospital submits its plan for public interest review by the 2022 deadline and follows the timelines in statute for public interest review.

Assumptions

The department licenses hospital beds described in the bill’s language. The department already has established processes and fees for the changing of hospital bed capacity. The bill permits, but does not require, the project to be undertaken. Therefore, the department cannot assume with any certainty when such fiscal impact may occur in the future or if it would occur. As a result, the department assumes no fiscal impact because of the language.
