## Overview

The hunger-free campus grant program provides grants of up to \$8,000 to postsecondary institutions to address food insecurity on campus. Currently, only public postsecondary institutions and Tribal colleges are eligible for the grants. This bill expands the program to allow nonprofit private postsecondary institutions to receive the grants.
