### Minnesota is the best and worse





- Affordability
- Economy
- Education & health
- Quality of life
- Safety

- Ranked 4<sup>th</sup> worse place for African Americans
- Home ownership—25% of black vs 76% of white
- Epicenter of racial injustice
  - Ongoing racial tensions—killing of:
    - Jamar Clark (2015)
    - Philando Castile (2016)
    - George Floyd (2020)





### Rondo was once the place for African Americans

- 80% of Saint Paul's African American population
- Vibrant culture
- Flourishing middle class
- Busting with business









## That changed with the I-94 construction (1956-1968)

Loss - 700 homes 300 Business

- Home Ownership 48% decline
- Population 61% decline
- Intergenerational wealth \$35m
- Education \$35m = 4800 college degrees
- A wealth gap \$157m from home equity alone



### Wrong is Wrong

- Rondo was literally split in half
- -700 African American owned homes were destroyed
- -300 African American businesses were destroyed
- -\$270 million home ownership equity gap in Rondo\*

## Yes, the land bridge is a big undertaking

- Length 2,600-3,200 lin. ft.
- Total capital cost up to \$458.9 million
- Total O&M cost up to \$6.9 million annually

\$6 -\$10 million Predevelopment (Q1 2021)

Master Plan development over 12 to 24 months:

- 1. Establish Team to Master Planning for Land Bridge
- 2. Increase Staff & Recruit Corporate CEO Champion
- 3. Prepare for Increased Property Value Implications
- 4. Identify Potential Land Bridge Anchors
- 5. Evaluate Redevelopment Plan & Redevelopment Authority

2022-2023

\$500 million Development

**Bridge Construction** 

1. Design and build Rondo Community Land Bridge 2024-2025

\$200 - \$300 million Development

Building construction

1. Develop the Rondo Community Land Bridge, incubate local business, arts, housing, healthy living, and education programs.

2026

\$7 million (annually) Project delivery

1. Ongoing operation and maintenance of the Rondo bridge structure, lid, and community.
