1.3 "Subd. 5. **Administrative costs.** (a) Agency administrative fees may not exceed one
1.4 percent of the amount appropriated to the agency for grants under this section.

1.5 (b) Administrative costs of a grantee may not exceed two percent of the amount of the
1.6 grant.

1.7 Subd. 6. **Reporting requirements for nonprofit grantees.** If a nonprofit organization
1.8 becomes a grantee under this section, the nonprofit must:

1.9 (1) by the January 15th following award of the grant, provide to the Office of the Attorney
1.10 General a copy of the most recently filed IRS 990 form;

1.11 (2) by January 15th each subsequent year, for as long as a nonprofit receives, uses, or
1.12 retains grant funds awarded under this section, provide to the Office of the Attorney General
1.13 copies of any subsequently filed IRS 990 forms and a report on how grant funds were used;
1.14 and

1.15 (3) by January 15th of each year, for as long as a nonprofit receives, uses, or retains
1.16 grant funds awarded under this section, report to the chairs and ranking minority members
1.17 of the legislative committees having jurisdiction over housing on the use of funds issued
1.18 under this section.

1.19 Subd. 7. **Agency oversight of nonprofit grantees.** Before issuing any grants under this
1.20 section, the agency must develop and implement policies and procedures providing for:

1.21 (1) reporting requirements for grantees; and

1.22 (2) agency inspection and oversight of grantees' use of funds."

2.1 Page 3, after line 20, insert:

2.2 "(f) Administrative costs of the agency in awarding grants may not exceed one percent
2.3 of the amount appropriated under this section. Administrative costs of a grantee may not
2.4 exceed two percent of the amount of the grant awarded.

2.5 (g) Nonprofit grantees must:

2.6 (1) by the January 15th after the grant is awarded, provide to the Office of the Attorney
2.7 General a copy of the most recently filed IRS 990 form;

2.8 (2) by January 15th of each year, for as long as the nonprofit receives, uses, administers,
2.9 or retains funds awarded under this section, provide to the Office of the Attorney General
2.10 copies of any subsequently filed IRS 990 forms and a report on how grant funds were used;
2.11 and

2.12 (3) by January 15th of each year, for as long as the nonprofit receives, uses, administers,
2.13 or retains funds awarded under this section, report to the chairs and ranking minority members
2.14 of the legislative committees having jurisdiction over housing on the use of funds issued
2.15 under this section.

2.16 (h) Before issuing any grants under this section, the agency must develop and implement
2.17 policies and procedures providing for:

2.18 (1) reporting requirements for grantees; and

2.19 (2) agency inspection and oversight of grantees' use of funds received under this section."
