1.2 Page 2, delete section 2 and insert:

1.3 "Sec. 2Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 256B.0625, subdivision 32, is amended to read:

1.4 Subd. 32. **Nutritional products.** Medical assistance covers nutritional products needed  
 1.5 for nutritional supplementation because solid food or nutrients thereof cannot be properly  
 1.6 absorbed by the body or needed for treatment of phenylketonuria, hyperlysinemia, maple  
 1.7 syrup urine disease, a combined allergy to human milk, cow's milk, and soy formula, or  
 1.8 any other childhood or adult diseases, conditions, or disorders identified by the commissioner  
 1.9 as requiring a similarly necessary nutritional product. Medical assistance covers amino  
 1.10 acid-based elemental formulas in the same manner as is required under section 62Q.524.  
 1.11 Nutritional products needed for the treatment of a combined allergy to human milk, cow's  
 1.12 milk, and soy formula require prior authorization. Separate payment shall not be made for  
 1.13 nutritional products for residents of long-term care facilities. Payment for dietary  
 1.14 requirements is a component of the per diem rate paid to these facilities."
