SUBJECT: HF 3606 - Proposed Changes to Minnesota Statute 326.10, Subdivision 8

Dear Chair Klevorn, Ranking Minority Member Nash, and Members of the State and Local Government Finance and Policy Committee:

The Minnesota Society of Professional Engineers (MnSPE) writes in support of HF 3606 which would require the Minnesota Board of Architecture, Engineering, Land Surveying, Landscape Architecture, Geoscience, and Interior Design (AELSLAGID) to send email notifications to professionals prior to their licensure lapsing.

MnSPE was founded in 1939 and is an affiliate of the National Society of Professional Engineers. MnSPE provides professional engineer licensure advocacy, professional development, and outreach for Minnesota's future STEM workforce for all engineering disciplines and industries in Minnesota. Our members include professional engineers, experienced career engineers, early career engineers, and students.

The Minnesota Board of Architecture, Engineering, Land Surveying, Landscape Architecture, Geoscience, and Interior Design (AELSLAGID) regulates the professions under Minnesota Statutes Section 326 who all share a common goal to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public.

HF 3606 allows for the modernization and expansion of the communication of the Board of AELSLAGID to licensed professionals to help them keep their licensure current during the biennial renewal period. MnSPE supports the proposed statute changes included in HF 3606 and appreciates the effort to communicate the renewal requirements to licensed professionals under the regulation of the Board of AELSLAGID.
