

Subject Assisting voters

Summary

Current law permits a voter who is unable to enter a polling place to register and cast a ballot without leaving their motor vehicle, with the assistance of two election judges of different major political party affiliations. As part of this process, the assisting election judges will physically bring a ballot and any needed registration paperwork from the inside polling place to the voter's vehicle, and then return it to the polling place after it is completed or marked.

This bill limits the election judges providing assistance in this process to only handling one voted ballot at a time.
