Summary

H.F. 3555 removes impediments to a customer's using a plug-in photovoltaic device, a solar panel with a maximum power output of 1,200 watts. The bill exempts those devices that have been certified as compliant with safety requirements established by a federally recognized testing laboratory from the need to enter an interconnection agreement with a utility and from state net metering provisions, and prohibits a utility from imposing any fee on or requiring any approval of a customer's deployment of such a device.
