1.4 Subd. 5. **Pre-election reports.** (a) Any loan, contribution, or contributions:

1.5 (1) to a political committee or political fund from any one source totaling more than
1.6 \$1,000;

1.7 (2) to the principal campaign committee of a candidate for an appellate court judicial
1.8 office totaling more than \$2,000;

1.9 (3) to the principal campaign committee of a candidate for district court judge totaling
1.10 more than \$400; or

1.11 (4) to the principal campaign committee of a candidate for constitutional office or for
1.12 the legislature totaling more than 50 percent of the election segment contribution limit for
1.13 the office,

1.14 received between the last day covered in the last report before an election and the election
1.15 must be reported to the board in the manner provided in paragraph (b).

1.16 (b) A loan, contribution, or contributions required to be reported to the board under
1.17 paragraph (a) must be reported to the board either:

1.18 (1) in person by the end of the next business day after its receipt; or

1.19 (2) by electronic means sent ~~within 24 hours after its receipt~~ by the end of the next
1.20 business day after its receipt.

1.21 (c) These loans and contributions must also be reported in the next required report.

2.1 (d) This notice requirement does not apply in a primary election to a candidate who is
2.2 unopposed in the primary, in a primary election to a ballot question political committee or
2.3 fund, or in a general election to a candidate whose name is not on the general election ballot.
2.4 The board must post the report on its website by the end of the next business day after it is
2.5 received.

2.6 (e) This subdivision does not apply to a ballot question or independent expenditure
2.7 political committee or fund that has not met the registration threshold of section 10A.14,
2.8 subdivision 1a. However, if a contribution that would be subject to this section triggers the
2.9 registration requirement in section 10A.14, subdivision 1a, then both registration under that
2.10 section and reporting under this section are required.

2.11 Sec. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 10A.20, subdivision 12, is amended to read:

2.12 Subd. 12. **Failure to file; late fees; penalty.** (a) If an individual or association fails to
2.13 file a report required by this section or section 10A.202, the board may impose a late filing
2.14 fee and a civil penalty as provided in this subdivision.

2.15 (b) If an individual or association fails to file a report required by this section that is due
2.16 January 31, the board may impose a late filing fee of \$25 per day, not to exceed \$1,000,
2.17 commencing the day after the report was due.

2.18 (c) If an individual or association fails to file a report required by this section that is due
2.19 before a primary or general election, subdivision 2, 2a, or 5, or by section 10A.202, the
2.20 board may impose a late filing fee of \$50 per day, not to exceed \$1,000, commencing on
2.21 the day after the date the statement was due, provided that if the total receipts received
2.22 during the reporting period or total expenditure reportable under section 10A.202 exceeds
2.23 \$25,000, then the board may impose a late filing fee of up to two percent of the amount that
2.24 should have been reported, per day, commencing on the day after the report was due, not
2.25 to exceed 100 percent of the amount that should have been reported.

2.26 (d) If an individual or association has been assessed a late filing fee or civil penalty
2.27 under this subdivision during the prior four years, the board may impose a late filing fee, a
2.28 civil penalty, or both, of up to twice the amount otherwise authorized by this subdivision.

2.29 (e) Within ten business days after the report was due or receipt by the board of
2.30 information disclosing the potential failure to file, the board must send notice by certified
2.31 mail to an individual who fails to file a report within ten business days after the report was
2.32 due that the individual or association may be subject to a civil penalty for failure to file the
2.33 report. An individual who fails to file the report within seven days after the certified mail

3.1 notice was sent by the board is subject to a civil penalty imposed by the board of up to
3.2 ~~\$1,000~~ \$2,000 in addition to the late filing fees imposed by this subdivision."

3.21 Subd. 5. **Late fees; failure to file; penalties.** A person who fails to file a report required
3.22 by this section is subject to the late fees and penalties provided in section 10A.20, subdivision
3.23 12."
