WORKERS' COMPENSATION

Ensures appropriate benefits are delivered to injured workers efficiently and at a reasonable cost. This division strives to create an environment where injured workers promptly receive benefits and services and where the system operates efficiently and cost-effectively.

Accomplishments

Reduction in system cost per \$100 of payroll from 2009 to 2019: 23% Reduction in businesses' average pure premium rates paid during 2011 to 2021: 26%

MINNESOTA OSHA COMPLIANCE AND CONSULTATION

Helps keep Minnesota workplaces safe and healthy through separate Compliance (workplace inspections and investigations) and Consultation (free voluntary workplace safety and health services) units.

Accomplishments (FFY 20)

11.1% decrease in injury and illness rate from the previous five-year average 97% of all safety and health consultations are conducted with small employers

CONSTRUCTION CODES AND LICENSING

Protects public health and safety through the enforcement of reasonable and uniform construction standards. Focused on improving efficiencies in the delivery of inspection, permitting, licensing and other construction regulatory services to industry stakeholders.

Construction permits issued online: 96%

Percentage of licenses renewed online: 92% (personal) and 83% (business)

LABOR STANDARDS

Ensures workers are paid correctly and workplace rights and responsibilities are enforced for all workers. This unit protects the rights of workers and educates employers and employees about their rights and responsibilities under Minnesota employment laws.

APPRENTICESHIP MINNESOTA

Fosters and promotes work-based career development. This unit develops and registers apprenticeship programs and promotes workforce diversity through outreach and education.

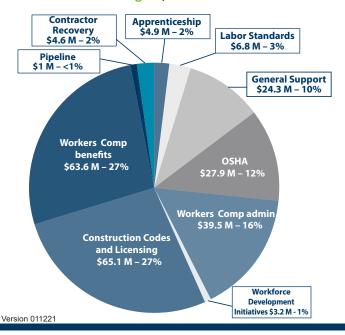
