

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 3490 as follows:

1.2 Page 2, after line 5, insert:

1.3 "(c) The Department of Education is authorized and encouraged to establish a nonprofit
1.4 corporation that is exempt from taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the federal Internal
1.5 Revenue Code as a scholarship granting organization under Public Law 119-21, section
1.6 70411, for the purpose of benefitting Minnesota's public schools and public school students.
1.7 The scholarship granting organization may encourage school districts and charter schools
1.8 to post on their websites qualified elementary or secondary education expenses for their
1.9 public schools including all authorized fees under sections 123B.34 to 123B.39, including
1.10 but not limited to extracurricular fees, driver education and other fees established by a
1.11 community education department, supplemental field trips, musical instruments, and pupil
1.12 transportation. The qualified education expenses also include tutoring services. Nothing in
1.13 this paragraph limits a school district, charter school, or other organization from establishing
1.14 a scholarship granting organization consistent with Public Law 119-21, section 70411."
