1.9 **(a) Supplemental Nonprofit Security Grants**

1.10 \$250,000 each year is for supplemental
1.11 nonprofit security grants under this paragraph.
1.12 This appropriation is onetime.

1.13 Nonprofit organizations whose applications
1.14 for funding through the Federal Emergency
1.15 Management Agency's nonprofit security grant
1.16 program have been approved by the Division
1.17 of Homeland Security and Emergency
1.18 Management are eligible for grants under this
1.19 paragraph. No additional application shall be
1.20 required for grants under this paragraph, and
1.21 an application for a grant from the federal
1.22 program is also an application for funding
1.23 from the state supplemental program.

2.1 Eligible organizations may receive grants of
2.2 up to \$75,000, except that the total received
2.3 by any individual from both the federal
2.4 nonprofit security grant program and the state
2.5 supplemental nonprofit security grant program
2.6 shall not exceed \$75,000. Grants shall be
2.7 awarded in an order consistent with the
2.8 ranking given to applicants for the federal
2.9 nonprofit security grant program. No grants
2.10 under the state supplemental nonprofit security
2.11 grant program shall be awarded until the
2.12 announcement of the recipients and the
2.13 amount of the grants awarded under the federal
2.14 nonprofit security grant program. This is a
2.15 onetime appropriation.

2.16 **(b) Emergency Preparedness Staff**

2.17 \$550,000 each year is for additional
2.18 emergency preparedness staff members.

2.19 **(c) Lake Superior Chippewa Tribal**
2.20 **Emergency Management Coordinator**

2.21 \$145,000 each year is for a grant to the Grand
2.22 Portage Band of Lake Superior Chippewa to
2.23 establish and maintain a Tribal emergency
2.24 management coordinator under Minnesota
2.25 Statutes, section 12.25.

2.26 **(d) Grand Portage Band of Lake Superior**
2.27 **Chippewa Tribe Coast Guard Services**

2.28 \$3,000,000 the first year is for a grant to the
2.29 Grand Portage Band of Lake Superior
2.30 Chippewa to purchase equipment and fund a
2.31 position for coast guard services off the north
2.32 shore of Lake Superior. This appropriation is
2.33 available until June 30, 2027."
