

**Subject** Student Teacher Stipends

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## Overview

College students enrolled in teacher preparation programs at higher education institutions are generally required to spend time student teaching before receiving a teacher license. A student teacher is placed in the K12 classroom by the higher education institution and performs teaching tasks under the direct supervision of a licensed K12 teacher. Most student teaching terms run for a 12-week period and are unpaid.

H.F. 3401 creates a grant program through the Office of Higher Education (OHE) for grants to students who participate in a year-long student teaching program. OHE currently operates a student teacher grant program.
