1.2 Delete everything after the enacting clause and insert:

1.3 "Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2022, section 97B.001, is amended by adding a subdivision
1.4 to read:

1.5 **Subd. 9. Placing traps or snares on private land; permission required.** (a) A person
1.6 may not set or place a trap or snare on private property other than property owned or occupied
1.7 by the person, unless the person has the written or verbal permission of the owner, occupant,
1.8 or lessee of the private property. The requirements under this subdivision include but are
1.9 not limited to, written or verbal permission to access private property from waters of the
1.10 state when the trap or snare is placed or staked in the water.

1.11 (b) For the purposes of this subdivision, "private property" does not include private
1.12 property required to be open to the public for purposes of taking game.

1.13 (c) This subdivision does not apply to a state or federal agency, road authority, or local
1.14 government unit, or their agent removing animals causing damage or otherwise being a
1.15 nuisance."
