Respected House and Senate Committee Members,

I want to bring forth several concerns with HF2431 as it pertains to the Private Career School Act:

- If 136A:82 CITATION is approved and updated by both House and Senate today:
  - "At the minimum, the definition of vocational should emphasize "skills for employment" within it to truly justify its meaning and limit its criteria."
- With the current changes proposed, if any entity does not choose to be on ETPL, does that entity automatically fall outside the "Private Career School Act" thus subject to no paperwork for even an exemption?
  - With the current definitions as well as the changes proposed, an entity that offers post-secondary training will still have to file an exemption paperwork with the regulatory body
- There are too many additional terms listed under this act that do not have definitions thus leading to significant differences in interpretation from an entity versus the regulatory body. Hence, I recommend that following minimum changes
  - Subd. 9. Program. "Program" means any course or grouping of courses that is advertised or listed in a private career school's <u>person's</u> catalog, brochures, electronic display, or other publications, or for which the private career school <u>person</u> grants a formal recognition. <u>A certificate of completion is not a formal recognition</u>.
  - Subd. 25. "Formal Recognition" means a credential or award that is issued upon completion of a course, or courses, of instruction below an associate degree level, which represents measurable academic or vocational achievement and is intended to have standalone labor-market value. Formal recognition does not include certificates of completion, certificates of participation, or other forms of recognition that signify completion of a course, or courses, of instruction.

I am confident that this committee with address the above-mentioned matters to its fullest extent during this session.
