1.2 Page 2, after line 2, insert:

1.3 "EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective upon federal approval of the continuation
1.4 of the state innovation waiver described in Laws 2021, First Special Session chapter 7,
1.5 article 15, section 4. The commissioner of commerce shall inform the revisor of statutes
1.6 when federal approval is obtained."

1.7 Page 2, after line 23, insert:

1.8 "EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective upon federal approval of the continuation
1.9 of the state innovation waiver described in Laws 2021, First Special Session chapter 7,

1.17 Page 3, after line 13, insert:

1.18 "EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective upon federal approval of the continuation
1.19 of the state innovation waiver described in Laws 2021, First Special Session chapter 7,
1.20 article 15, section 4. The commissioner of commerce shall inform the revisor of statutes
1.21 when federal approval is obtained.

2.1 Sec. 5. **TRANSFER.**

2.2 The commissioner of management and budget shall transfer \$42,465,000 from the general
2.3 fund to the health care access fund by June 30, 2024, for state basic health plan costs related
2.4 to the loss of federal revenue associated with the extension of the premium security plan
2.5 through plan year 2023. This is a onetime transfer.

2.6 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2023, but only if the
2.7 continuation of the state innovation waiver described in Laws 2021, First Special Session
2.8 chapter 7, article 15, section 4, is approved and results in a loss of federal revenue for the
2.9 state basic health plan for plan year 2023. The commissioner of management and budget
2.10 shall inform the revisor of statutes upon this occurrence."
