Re: DE Amendments to HF 669 and HF 670

Chair Lee and members of the House Capital Investment Committee:

The League of Minnesota Cities appreciates the opportunity to comment on the proposed spending packages for public infrastructure projects found in the 2/13/23 DE amendments to HF 669 and HF 670, both authored by Chair Lee. The League supports both bills and urges their passage, as they contain badly needed funding for public infrastructure. While we hope that by the end of the 2023 session the legislature is able to provide infrastructure funding equaling or exceeding the Governor's proposed capital budget, we see these bills as an extremely important start to covering the needs addressed there.

In particular, we appreciate the inclusion of capital investment resources for:

- local roads, bridges, wetland replacement, and other transportation and transit needs,
- city water, wastewater, and stormwater infrastructure,
- public housing rehabilitation and resources for public infrastructure to support residential development in Greater Minnesota,
- flood hazard mitigation,
- community tree planting, and
- important specific local projects identified in both bills

The League will continue to work with Chair Lee, the rest of the legislature, and the administration to take advantage of the opportunity the state has this session to make historic levels of investment in addressing the public infrastructure needs of Minnesota.
