\$250,000 in fiscal year 2026 and \$250,000 in fiscal year 2027 are appropriated from the general fund to the commissioner of children, youth, and families for grants to nationally recognized forensic interview protocol organizations to award scholarships for basic forensic interview training, advanced forensic interview training, and training on specialized interview topics.
