Overview

ServeMinnesota is the statutorily designated recipient of federal Americorps funds. It combines state money with federal money and provides participants in youth service programs with living expenses or a stipend, health insurance, child care if needed, and a postservice educational award that may be used for higher education costs or to repay student loans. ServeMinnesota operates Reading Corps and Math Corps. Section 124D.42 establishes program requirements for both Reading Corps and Math Corps.

This bill modifies requirements for Minnesota Math Corps and appropriates money for the program.

Summary

Section Description

1 Minnesota math corps program. [Reading and math corps]

Requires Minnesota math corps to use evidence-based instructional support to evaluate and accelerate student learning on foundational mathematics skills.

2 Appropriation; math corps.

Appropriates \$2,000,000 for math corps in fiscal year 2026 and \$1,000,000 in fiscal year 2027. (The base for math corps is \$1,000,000 per fiscal year.)
