1.8 Subd. 6. **Biennial Annual audit.** (a) In addition to the log required under subdivision
1.9 5, the law enforcement agency must maintain records showing the date and time automated
1.10 license plate reader data were collected and the applicable classification of the data. The
1.11 law enforcement agency shall arrange for an independent, ~~biennial~~ annual audit of the
1.12 records to determine whether data currently in the records are classified, how the data are
1.13 used, whether they are destroyed as required under this section, and to verify compliance
1.14 with subdivision 7. If the commissioner of administration believes that a law enforcement
1.15 agency is not complying with this section or other applicable law, the commissioner may
1.16 order a law enforcement agency to arrange for additional independent audits. Data in the
1.17 records required under this paragraph are classified as provided in subdivision 2.

1.18 (b) The results of the audit are public. The commissioner of administration shall review
1.19 the results of the audit. If the commissioner determines that there is a pattern of substantial
1.20 noncompliance with this section by the law enforcement agency, the agency must
1.21 immediately suspend operation of all automated license plate reader devices until the
1.22 commissioner has authorized the agency to reinstate their use. An order of suspension under
1.23 this paragraph may be issued by the commissioner, upon review of the results of the audit,

2.1 review of the applicable provisions of this chapter, and after providing the agency a
2.2 reasonable opportunity to respond to the audit's findings.

2.3 (c) ~~A report summarizing the results of each audit must be provided~~ No later than 30
2.4 days following completion of the audit, the law enforcement agency must provide to the
2.5 commissioner of administration, to the chairs and ranking minority members of the
2.6 committees of the house of representatives and the senate with jurisdiction over data practices
2.7 and public safety issues, and to the Legislative Commission on Data Practices and Personal
2.8 Data Privacy ~~no later than 30 days following completion of the audit.~~ a report that:

2.9 (1) summarizes the results of each audit;

2.10 (2) list all data-sharing agreements that the agency has in place regarding its automated
2.11 license plate data;

2.12 (3) states the total number of queries or searches of the agency's automated license plate
2.13 data by other law enforcement agencies over the past 12 months; and

2.14 (4) states the total number of instances where the agency disseminated or shared its
2.15 automated license plate data to persons outside the state."
