1.2 (H0239DE1), as follows:

1.3 Page 13, after line 15, insert:

1.4 "Subd. 12. **Annual legislative report.** A utility whose innovation plan has been approved  
1.5 by the commission under this section must, beginning one year after commission approval  
1.6 of the plan, and continuing each year thereafter, submit a report to the chairs and ranking  
1.7 minority members of the senate and house of representatives committee with primary  
1.8 jurisdiction over energy policy that contains the following information:

1.9 (1) the lifecycle greenhouse gas emissions and lifecycle greenhouse gas emissions  
1.10 intensity of the utility's natural gas operations in Minnesota in 2020;

1.11 (2) the lifecycle greenhouse gas emissions and lifecycle greenhouse gas emissions  
1.12 intensity of each of the pilot programs the utility has implemented under an approved  
1.13 innovation plan during the previous 12 months; and

1.14 (3) an estimate of the social cost of the lifecycle greenhouse gas emissions in clauses  
1.15 (1) and (2), utilizing the most recent methodology used by the federal Environmental  
1.16 Protection Agency to measure the social cost of greenhouse gas emissions, and employing  
1.17 a discount rate no greater than three percent."
