1.2 follows:

1.3 Page 2, after line 3, insert:

1.4 "(e) Notwithstanding paragraph (d), the commissioner may pursue termination of a
1.5 Medicaid program, waiver, or benefit without prior enactment of legislative authorization
1.6 if, based on credible allegations of fraud as described under section 256B.064, subdivision
1.7 2, paragraph (b), clause (2), the commissioner determines that terminating the program,
1.8 waiver, or benefit is necessary to safeguard Medicaid enrollees and protect the fiscal integrity
1.9 of the state's Medicaid program. If the commissioner pursues termination of a Medicaid
1.10 program, waiver, or benefit without prior enactment of legislative authorization, the
1.11 commissioner shall notify the chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative
1.12 committees with jurisdiction over health and human services policy and finance within ten
1.13 days of initiating the process to terminate the program, waiver, or benefit."
