1.2 Page 8, after line 17, insert:

1.3 "Sec. 18. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 97A.411, subdivision 1, is amended to read:

1.4 Subdivision 1. **License period.** (a) Except as provided in paragraphs (b), (d), (e), and
1.5 (f), a license is valid during the lawful time within the license year that the licensed activity
1.6 may be performed. Except as provided in paragraphs (c) ~~and~~ (f), (g), and (h), a license year
1.7 begins on the first day of March and ends on the last day of February.

1.8 (b) A short-term license issued under section 97A.475 that is limited by the number of
1.9 days or hours under section 97A.475, is valid for the full license period even if this period
1.10 extends into the next license year, provided that the license period selected by the licensee
1.11 begins at the time of issuance.

1.12 (c) The license year for resident fish house, resident dark house, and nonresident fish
1.13 house begins on March 1 and ends on April 30 of the following year.

1.14 (d) A lifetime license issued under section 97A.473 or 97A.474 is valid during the lawful
1.15 time within the license year that the licensed activity may be performed for the lifetime of
1.16 the licensee.

1.17 (e) A three-year fish house or dark house license is valid during the license year that it
1.18 is purchased and the two succeeding license years.

1.19 (f) A three-year individual angling license is valid during the license year in which it is
1.20 purchased and the two succeeding license years.

1.21 (g) The license year for an annual angling license begins on the day of purchase and
1.22 ends one year from the day of purchase.

- 2.1 (h) The license year for an annual small game license begins on the day of purchase and
- 2.2 ends one year from the day of purchase."
