

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 4615 as follows:

1.2 Page 1, line 7, delete the new language

1.3 Page 1, delete lines 14 to 17 and insert:

1.4 "(c) Once determined eligible for medical assistance, a child under the age of 21 is
1.5 continuously eligible for a period of 12 months unless:

1.6 (1) the child reaches age 21;

1.7 (2) the child requests voluntary termination of coverage;

1.8 (3) the child ceases to be a resident of Minnesota;

1.9 (4) the child dies; or

1.10 (5) the agency determines the child's eligibility was erroneously granted due to agency
1.11 error or enrollee fraud, abuse, or perjury."

1.12 Page 1, delete line 18 and insert:

1.13 "**EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective January 1, 2024, or upon federal
1.14 approval, whichever is later. The commissioner of human services shall notify the revisor
1.15 of statutes when federal approval is obtained."

1.16 Amend the title as follows:

1.17 Page 1, line 3, delete "a person 20 years of age or younger" and insert "a child under the
1.18 age of 21"
