## **Summary**

This bill repeals town planning and zoning statutes in Minnesota Statutes, chapter 366, and codifies a new section in chapter 366 stating that a town board that adopted land use, zoning, and restrictions under chapter 366 before the effective date has the same authority under Minnesota Statutes, chapter 462.

Minnesota Statutes, chapter 462 is a municipal planning and zoning chapter of the law. The municipal planning sections of the chapter apply to home rule charter and statutory cities and towns.

Effective the day following final enactment.
