The Minnesota Board of Medical Practice (Board) is authorized to license and regulate Physician Assistants and enforce their practice act, Minn. Stat. §147A.

Please accept this letter as confirmation that, at its business meeting on January 11, 2025, the Board passed a motion to support the proposed changes to Minn. Stat. §147A.02(c) allowing the required 2,080 collaborative practice hours a physician assistant must complete to be with a physician licensed in Minnesota or another state or United States territory. That proposed language has now been introduced as SF1083/HF89.
