

## Minnesota Board of Dentistry Bill HF3516

### Summary

- Replaces “dental school or schools” with “dental and allied dental education programs” to align with CODA terminology (technical update).
- Updates the Specialty Dentist section to reflect the correct name: National Commission on Recognition of Dental Specialties and Certifying Board (technical update).
- Removes records and interview language in the Specialty Dentist section to align with current licensure by credential processes (technical update).
- Adds dental therapists to the guest license section, consistent with other allied dental professions (technical update).
- Updates continuing education waiver language to remove outdated terms and align references to lower-income patients (technical update).
- Revises CPR language to allow additional course sponsors and align with the statutory CPR definition (technical update).
- Aligns the Emeritus license section with other license expirations and updates CE language to reference language already in Board administrative rule (technical update).
- Makes additional minor technical and conforming updates throughout.
- Adds felony criminal sexual misconduct convictions to grounds for discipline and removes outdated language.
- Increases supervision limit in the Collaborative Dental Hygiene section from 4 to 8 to improve patient access to collaborative dental hygiene services.
- Removes outdated language in the Restorative Functions section to align with Board-approved curriculum.
- Clarifies the Collaborative Management Agreement section by removing unclear referral language.
- Allows for reinstatement fee for limited radiology registrants.
