1.7 (1) authorizes the director to conduct a lottery game or contest the winner or winners
1.8 of which are determined by the result of a sporting event other than a horse race conducted
1.9 under chapter 240;

1.10 (2) authorizes the director to install or operate a lottery device operated by coin or
1.11 currency which when operated determines the winner of a game; ~~and~~

1.12 (3) authorizes the director to sell pull-tabs as defined under section 349.12,
1.13 subdivision 32.; and

1.14 (4) authorizes the director to offer the play of, on an electronic terminal, through a
1.15 Web site, or by any other means or device, casino-style games, including but not limited
1.16 to blackjack, craps, keno, dice games, roulette, or poker.

1.22 (a) By September 30, 2014, the director of the State Lottery shall suspend the sale
1.23 of lottery tickets through: (1) a self-service device that is part of, shares a display with,
1.24 or is adjacent to a retail petroleum dispenser under Minnesota Statutes, section 239.751,

2.1 including all contracts related to this activity; and (2) a self -service device that is part of,
2.2 shares a display with, or is adjacent to an electronic financial terminal under Minnesota
2.3 Statutes, section 47.61, subdivision 3, including all contracts related to this activity. The
2.4 suspension under this paragraph remains in effect until repealed or amended by law.

2.5 (b) By September 30, 2014, the director of the State Lottery shall suspend the sale of
2.6 instant win lottery tickets through a Web site, including all contracts related to this activity.
2.7 The suspension under this paragraph remains in effect until repealed or amended by law.
2.8 The suspension under this paragraph does not apply to the sale of tickets of a joint lottery
2.9 within the meaning of Minnesota Statutes, section 349A.02, subdivision 3, or games
2.10 that rely on a drawing to select a winner."
