HF 1914-1E adds advanced practice registered nurses (APRN) to numerous Minnesota statutes including the following that fall under Commerce's regulatory purview: Minn. Stat. 62D.09, 62E.06, 62J.17, 62J.23, 62J.495, 62J.52, 62J.823, 62Q.184, 62Q.43, 62Q.53, 62Q.57, 62Q.73, 62Q.733, 62Q.74, 62S.08, 62S.20, 62S.21, 62S.268.

Assumptions

Commerce does not regulate advanced practice registered nurses and would only have additional work if there was a complaint under the underlying statute. Complaints are not frequent. Commerce assumes no cost for this bill.

Bill Description

In Minnesota statutes, physicians are specifically given certain rights, duties, and protections and the authority to perform certain acts. The bill adds APRN, APRN clinic, a specific type of APRN, or a health care provider that includes an APRN, to existing language that gives physicians certain rights, duties, and protections, or authority to perform certain acts. In a few instances, the term APRN replaces the term nurse practitioner.

Assumptions

This bill adds APRN to existing provisions associated with physicians for settings regulated by MDH. Because MDH currently enforces provisions for physicians, adding APRN as another health provider for regulatory purposes will not increase costs to MDH.

Bill Description

HF1914-1E will add advanced practice registered nurses (APRN) as a professional classification for providing health care services.

Assumptions

MMB administers the State Employee Group Insurance Program (SEGIP) which provides health, dental, life and other benefits to eligible state employees and their dependents, as well as for the quasi-state agencies under the authority provided in Minnesota Statutes 43A. Health benefits are provided through the self-funded Minnesota Advantage Health Plan.

SEGIP contracts with plan administrators to maintain a network of licensed health care providers. This legislation will add APRNs as an eligible classification to provide health care services to members. Over time, and for some members, MMB expects that a certain number of services performed today by physicians will be performed by APRNs instead. Industry data shows that services performed by APRNs cost roughly 15% less than those performed by physicians, meaning costs will likely decrease as a result of this bill. However, without knowing which specific services will see substitution of providers, MMB is unable to determine a savings amount, and so we are not showing a fiscal impact on this note.
