HF1653 (Hassan) Northstar Care for Children child under the age of six benefits modified.

HF2264 (Wazlawik) Retaining early educators through attaining incentives now (REETAIN) grant program established, reports required, and money appropriated.

HF1703 (Richardson) Child care assistance to low-income workers increase to enable higher-quality early childhood care and education provided, child care assistance reimbursement rates increased, and basic sliding fee child care assistance program forecasted.
