The Austin Bruins and Rochester Grizzlies are junior hockey teams that offer playing opportunities for hockey players from all over the world to showcase their talents for NCAA schools. Our philosophy is to offer a safe and exciting place for these young men to play the game of hockey. We also make it our top priority to be a great partner in the communities that we play in. Offering not only a fun, family entertainment option, but also being a valuable part of the community. Every year through the Austin Bruins Foundation our players donate up to, and sometimes exceed, over 500 hours of community service along with different charitable fundraisers. This season we have raised over \$60,000 for different local charities like The Hormel Institute with our Paint the Rink Pink night, and our Pink in the Rink night in Rochester where we raised money for cancer research with the Mayo clinic.
