

PARKERS PRAIRIE VETERAN'S MEMORIAL

Above is an artist's rendition of the proposed Veteran's Memorial. The Memorial site is in the southern half of "Monument Park" on South Otter Avenue ("Old Hwy. 29") overlooking Lake Adley.

The site was chosen for its peaceful surroundings and beautiful view of the lake. The Memorial will be visible to travelers on Highway 29 entering Parkers Prairie from the South, and accessible to the biking/walking path to Adley Park.

The Memorial will be constructed with a concrete floor and landscaping stone. At the base of the large granite folded flag will be the engraved words "IN HONOR OF ALL WHO SERVED," and each of the six white granite benches will display the insignia of one of the branches of service.

The cost of the proposed Veteran's Memorial is \$134,976. The construction of the Memorial will funded solely through donations.



This Veteran's Memorial is designed to be a tribute to ALL military service men and women; past, present, and future. It is meant to be a tribute that will be easily maintained for decades to come. It is for these reasons that the Veteran's Memorial Committee has decided not to include the names of individual Veterans in the Memorial. The Committee has also chosen not to include within the memorial names of individuals, groups, or businesses who make donations toward the Memorial, so that the focus can remain on the purpose of the Memorial: to honor those who serve, who have served, and who will serve our country in the years to come.

The Veteran's Memorial Committee has partnered with West Central Initiative (WCI) to assist with the fundraising for this project.
