Subject ICF/DD rate increase for a facility in Big Stone County

Overview

This bill provides a rate increase for an intermediate care facility for persons with developmental disabilities (ICF/DD) located in Big Stone County.

ICFs/DD are medical assistance (MA) facilities that serve persons with developmental disabilities and related conditions who require the level of care provided in an ICF/DD and who choose such services. These facilities are licensed supervised living facilities and serve from four to 64 persons.

Class A supervised living facilities include homes for ambulatory and mobile persons who are capable of taking appropriate action for self-preservation under emergency circumstances.

Class B supervised living facilities include homes for ambulatory, nonambulatory, mobile, or nonmobile persons who are not mentally or physically capable of taking appropriate action for self-preservation under emergency circumstances.

Minnesota contracts with ICF/DD facilities for services and sets rates for each facility. Persons may pay through private insurance, Medicare, MA, and/or a combination of all three. Services are a predesigned package and include:

- room and board;
- services during the day, active treatment, and functional skill development; and
- transportation.

Related medical services may be covered as part of the rate.

Summary

Section Description

1 ICF/DD rate increase effective July 1, 2023; Big Stone County.

Amends § 256B.5012, by adding subd. 19. Effective July 1, 2023, increases the daily rate for a specified ICF/DD located in Big Stone County from \$142.09 to \$250. Specifies this increase is in addition to any other increase that is effective on July 1, 2023.
