

1.1 moves to amend H.F. No. 145 as follows:

1.2 Page 2, line 1, before "Subdivision" insert "(a)"

1.3 Page 2, lines 9 to 11, delete the new language

1.4 Page 2, lines 12 to 15, reinstate the stricken language and delete the new language

1.5 Page 2, after line 25, insert:

1.6 "(b) For the purposes of paragraph (a), clause (2), a driver of a vehicle may rely on a
1.7 prescription or physician's statement of medical need issued to a person not present in the
1.8 vehicle if:

1.9 (1) the prescription or physician's statement of medical need is issued to the driver's
1.10 parent, child, grandparent, sibling, or spouse;

1.11 (2) the prescription or physician's statement of medical need specifies the make, model,
1.12 and license plate of one or two vehicles that will have tinted windows; and

1.13 (3) the driver is in possession of the prescription or physician's statement of medical
1.14 need.

1.15 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** Paragraph (b) is effective on November 1, 2019.

1.16 Sec. 2. **PRESCRIPTION FOR GLAZED WINDOWS.**

1.17 Until November 1, 2019, for the purposes of Minnesota Statutes, section 169.71,
1.18 subdivision 4a, paragraph (b), clause (2), a driver of a vehicle may rely on a prescription
1.19 or physician's statement of medical need issued to a person not present in the vehicle if:

1.20 (1) the prescription or physician's statement of medical need is issued to a family member
1.21 of the driver; and

- 2.1 (2) the driver is in possession of the prescription or physician's statement of medical
- 2.2 need.
- 2.3 **EFFECTIVE DATE.** This section is effective the day following final enactment."
