North Point Inc. is a community-based human services agency, offering resources such as a food shelf, MNSure, employment and housing assistance.



NorthPoint began testing patients and community members at our clinical locations in March 2020. We currently provide walk-in testing at our main clinic at 1313 Penn Ave. North and a drive-up testing at our parking ramp at 1256 Penn Ave. North.


NorthPoint also co-sponsors virtual town halls, community food and masks distributions and support for local community education and testing events.
