Hmong came to the U.S. as war refugees starting in 1975 following their involvement with the U.S. CIA efforts during the war in Vietnam. The 2010 **US Census counted over 260,000** Hmong in the U.S. and almost 70,000 Hmong in Minnesota. Hmong continue to face wide disparities in the areas of employment, education, healthcare, housing, and they continue to face discrimination and racism as they make their lives in America.
